The Medical Department of the Naval Communication Station consisted of a 15-bed dispensary with the assigned responsibility for providing medical care to base military and dependent personnel; U. S. Department of Defense civilians and their dependents; personnel and dependents of American Embassies and Consulates; Agency for International Development personnel; members of the Peace Corps; American contractor personnel and their dependents; and approved foreign nationals throughout East Africa.

The staff of the Medical Department was composed of six doctors, eight nurses and four Medical Service Corps officers, with a peak strength of 84 enlisted hospital corpsmen of various medical specialties.

The doctors assigned to NavComm Sta were specialists in the following fields: Internist; Obstetrics/Gynecology; Pediatrics; Surgery; and General Practice.

The Medical Service Corps officers specialized in the fields of Administration; Optometry; Environmental Sanitation; and Medical Supply/Finance.

This staff accommodated between 650-800 outpatients during an average month. The average inpatient admission rate was approximately 35, with a peak of 51.

Because of the remote location of Nav CommSta, aeromedical evacuation flights were utilized twice each month. These flights were employed for any diagnosis or treatment beyond the capability of the Medical Department. The patients were flown to Germany for outpatient consultations or to the United States for extended inpatient care at designated hospitals.
