Update #3

Greetings to all -

Although lots of details have been finalized recently, a few critical ones still remain to be completed.

A request has been made to the NSA for a speaker for Saturday night's dinner. As nearly all Kagnew units were somehow connected to the NSA (although at that time it was officially referred to as "No Such Agency"), the request was made for an unclassified presentation on the role Kagnew units fulfilled for NAS's mission and what difference Kagnew made to not only the Nation's security but to global and regional security as well. Still awaiting word whether a speaker will be available on the date of our reunion. When we hear something, I'll let you know.

Some new details:

Transportation to and from the Charleston Airport

Contact **TC Transportation Service in advance (843-343-6568)** and speak with **Todd Comstock**. He has quoted us special rates for transportation to and from the airport to the hotel. Tell him you are attending the Kagnew Station Reunion for his special rates.

Attendance:

As of this morning (7/10/17), we have 30 paid registrations, with 73 (and counting) reservations planned. We have Kagnew veterans of Headquarters Co., Companies A&B, STRATCOM, 9th Signal as well as dependents (the Kagnew Kids) registered, so this is truly an "All-Kagnew" event. We also have Kagnew Vets representing all three decades of the 1950's, 1960's and the 1970's registered, so a lot of Kagnew memories will have an opportunity to be shared. It is possible we will have Vet's from Kagnew's earliest days to the final days of operations.


