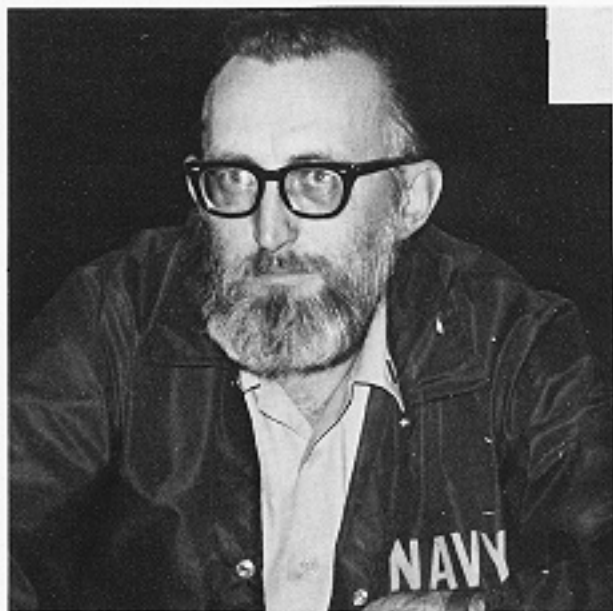

Communications was the name of the game and therefore the Communications Department was the most important and most heavily obligated on base.

With less than one-third of its authorized strength, Comm was faced with myriad responsibilities including Navy and USNS fleet broadcast net; CW net; crypto on-call circuits; base telephone exchange; world-wide AUTOVON system; satellite terminal; ground-air-ground system; base message center; and maintenance of a major CMS account. All of this was in addition to providing general message service throughout the Middle East; support of ComMidEast Force; coordination of telecommunication stations in both east and west Africa; providing technical assistance to the Ethiopian government, MAAG, and U.S. Navy units in port at Mas-sawa; maintaining DCS trunks to Europe and the Middle East; and furnishing ship riders to various ocean areas to assist in longhaul communications.
