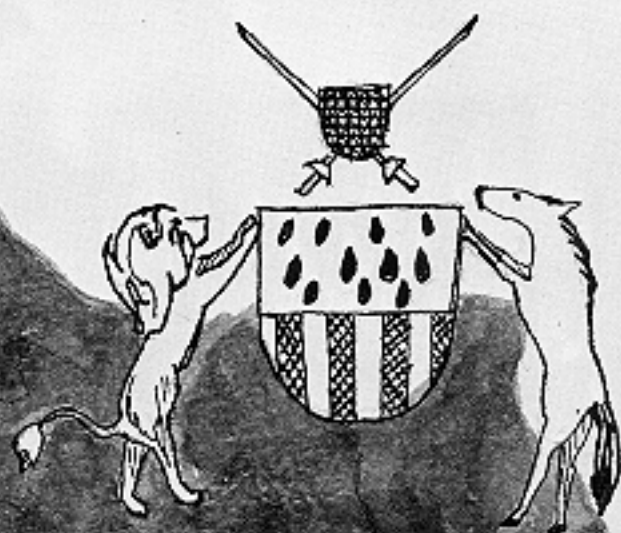
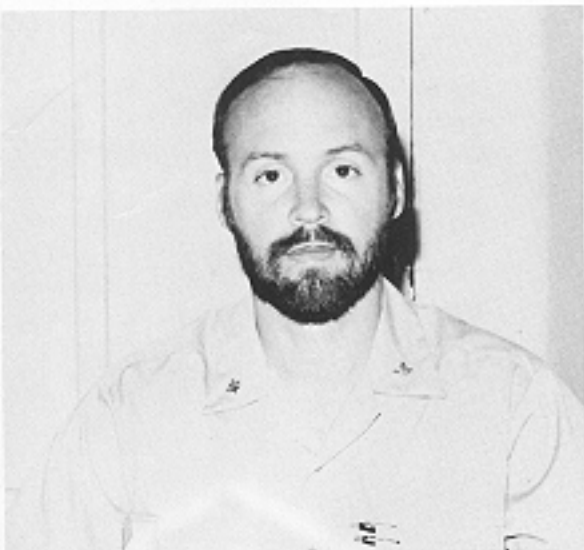
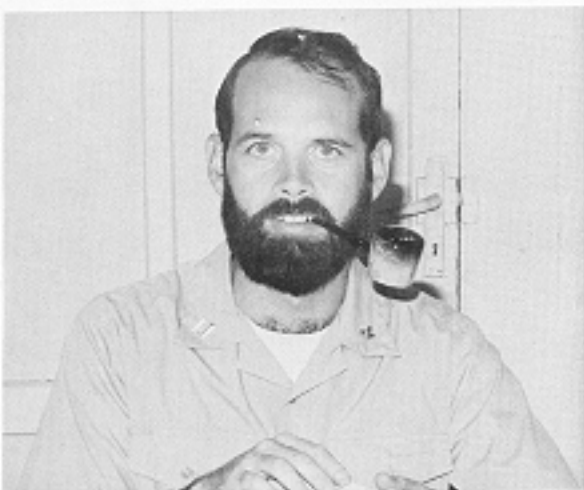

Supply bore the brunt of the headaches during turnover and closure of the base. Supply divisions had an impact upon everyone. The Material and Control division alone had an inventory of nearly 35,000 items worth \$2 million.

Budget and Accounting: Increased from \$700,000 in FY73 to \$2.8 million in FY74; turned over 3,800 items to other activities at closure.

Purchasing and Contracting: All open purchases on the local economy—guards, gas, milk, meat, laundry, janitorial services, produce, etc.

Customs: Inspection of all shipments and clearance of vehicles.

During the final days, Supply was put to the test - and passed with flying colors.

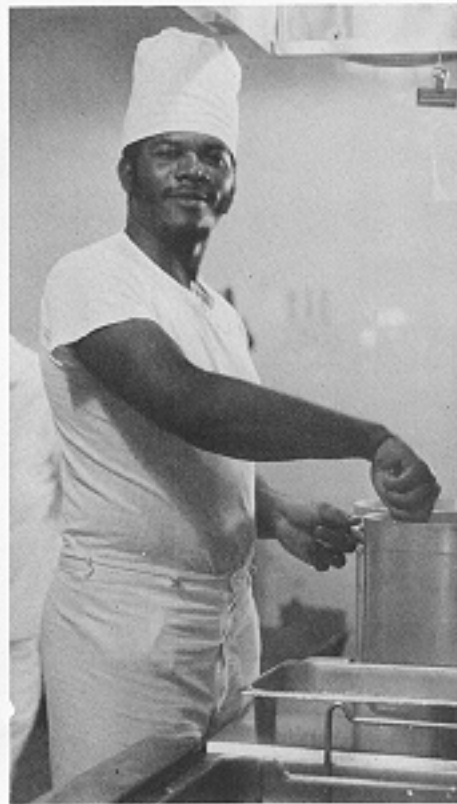

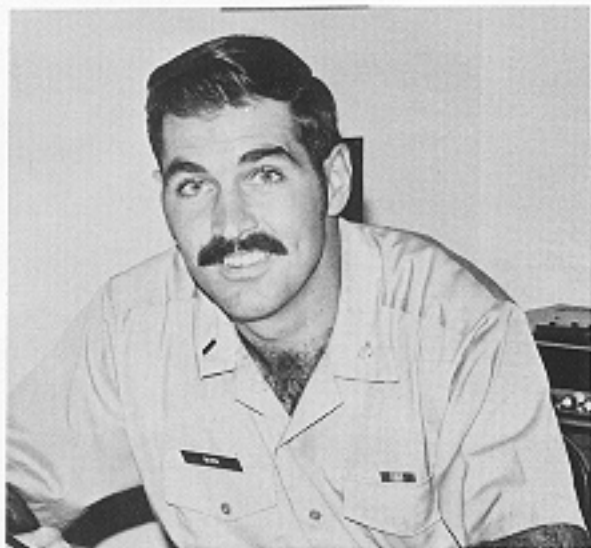
FOOD SERVICES: Increased from 30 meals a day at one galley to over 350 meals a day at three locations. Operators of Mom's Place.
