Jerry Williams, Kagnew Veteran (1962-1964) has again designed and produced another exclusive piece of memorabilia for our reunion. These memorabilia have long been used to help offset the costs associated with the reunion and hospitality room. The 2" diameter coin has a plated satin-brass finish with a painted Kagnew Crest. Each coin is encased in a protective plastic case.
